This year the walk will be in the west end.

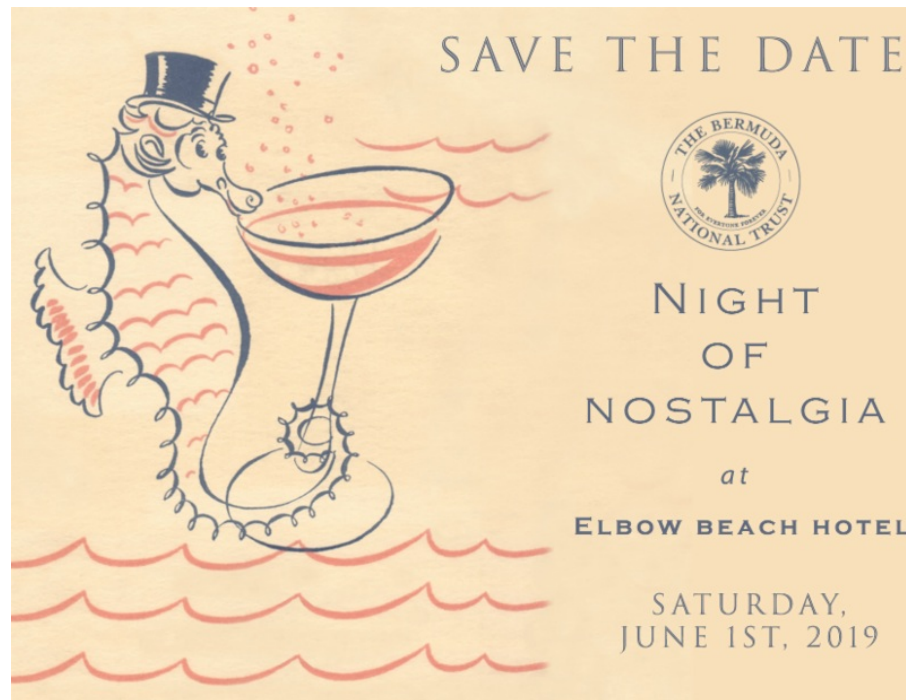

## Conservation Officer

Reporting to the Director of Preservation, the Conservation Officer is responsible for BNT's conservation work and environmental advocacy.

**The responsibilities include development, coordination and management of:**

- Woodland management within BNT nature reserves;
- Conservation and capital projects in BNT open spaces;
- Community volunteer programmes and projects
- Cemeteries and memorials under the care of BNT;
- BNT agricultural holdings and community gardens;
- BNT moorings and punt storage;
- BNT's annual Palm Sunday Walk;
- BNT's environmental advocacy.

**The successful candidate will:**

Have experience in a comparable role or a tertiary level qualification in horticulture, land management or a related conservation field is required, as well as a proven active interest in Bermuda's natural and historical protection. An understanding of Bermuda's environmental legislation would be an asset.

Experience in the use of a chainsaw as well as horticultural expertise in removing invasive species are essential.

Good written, verbal communication skills and computer skills are necessary. An intermediate truck licence is required. The position is full time; working hours will include some weekend work to suit volunteer projects as required.
