With International Artist Eli Cedrone May 11, 2019 - 2:00 - 4:00 pm









# **BERMUDA NATIONAL TRUST**



The Bermuda National Trust offers fun camps for children aged 8 to 11. Each program week includes interesting field trips to Bermuda's prime nature reserves and historic sites, a variety of hands-on activities and fun indoor and outdoor games.

### Crack the Code Camp (July 1-5 and July 8-12)

This camp is perfect for puzzlers and scientific sleuths. Discover a world of special alphabets, codes and their uses. Learn about hidden messages that passed through Bermuda and the people that decoded them. Create your own mystery with a team and design a scavenger hunt.

Awesome Trails Camp (July 15-19 and August 12-16) CAMP FULL Participants will enjoy a week of healthy outdoor fun on Bermuda's beautiful trails, beaches and nature reserves. They will learn about natural history, heritage and field skills while hiking, scavenger hunting and exploring together. Activities at our education centre at Waterville will include healthy snack making, eco-printing and traditional games.

#### Pirates, Boats and Forts Camp (July 22-26)

Ahoy there, matey! This camp is for you if you would like to learn about the life of pirates, pirate ships, navigation and the history of Bermuda's forts. Have fun while building boats, water cannons, cardboard forts and trebuchets. Join a treasure hunt, with arts and crafts to be created in the Waterville classroom.

Creative LEGO Camp (July 29-31 and August 5-9) CAMP FULL Calling all young LEGO robot designers! This exciting camp uses the LEGO WeDo2.0 system which is a fantastic new learning tool that introduces students to robotics, engineering and programming. Our fun projects are linked to technology in Bermuda and science topics such as plants and pollinators, habitats, animal senses, ocean pollution and transport. This camp nurtures teamwork, creativity and problem-solving and includes field trips and outdoor activities.
