Time Travellers Camp 29 June - 3 July

Spend the week time travelling and learning about some of the world's ancient cultures and civilizations. From Native Americans to the Indigenous People of Australia, we travel the virtual globe and uncover the past. Participate in an online museum scavenger hunt, create origami throwing stars, listen to Dreamtime stories and paint bark art, develop your hunting skills with ancient games – these are just some of the wonderful activities on offer!

Dirt Diggers 6 July - 10 July

Campers will spend the week learning the basics of archaeology. Children learn about stratigraphy, the tools of the trade, and how archaeologists date sites. We plan to visit Smith's Island, the site of Bermuda's very first settlement and the BNT archaeology lab in St George's. The children will then undertake a real-life two day dig in the garden at Waterville. What treasures will we uncover this year?

Fantastic Photography 13 July - 17 July

This week teaches campers the basics of photography. Each day has a different skill focus with the children travelling the island from east to west to practice and take pictures, exploring places such as Tom Moore's Jungle, St George's, Dockyard and Cooper's Island. Afternoons are spent editing and creating an electronic exhibition of their work, crafting activities and games.

Trash to Treasure **NEW** 20 July - 24 July

Turn your trash into treasure and help save the planet! This week campers will be learning the art of upcycling, transforming old belongings or trash into new and exciting creations! Shoeboxes become amazing pinball machines; old clothing is redesigned with paint or jewels; wooden boxes are transformed into useful storage; craft with nature to create beautiful ornaments. Join the camp where creativity has no limits!

Fantastic Photography 2 3 Aug - 7 Aug

Building on the skills learned in Fantastic Photography, we focus on portraits, landscapes, macro-photography, using props and capturing motion. Campers go out each day to practice the new skills. Afternoons are spent editing, compiling an electronic presentation of their work, and creating beautiful and unusual photograph frames.

Hunt for the Lost Treasure! **NEW**

10 Aug - 14 Aug

This week, campers hunt for the Lost Treasure of the Triangle. Each day a different theme sees the children undertaking puzzles and scavenger hunts, following treasure maps and hidden trails, seeking out strange objects and solving riddles. Each day, campers try to win a Secret Key and uncover more evidence to the final location of the treasure.

Fabulous Forts **NEW** 17 Aug - 21 Aug

Spend the week exploring Bermuda's truly remarkable and special forts. We visit the island's very own World Heritage Site and learn about how war changed the island forever. From east we head west to Dockyard to investigate Bermuda's maritime history. Back at Waterville, campers will be creating their own model forts, with fun and games in the garden each afternoon.

Nature Detectives Camp **NEW**

24 Aug - 28 Aug

This week we travel to a different nature reserve each day to learn about the island's incredible native and endemic flora and fauna. We link up live with the Bahamas National Trust, who will take us on a tour through their island's primeval forests. Back at Waterville we craft with nature, play nature themed games and have fun in the garden!
